## Adult Day Program

Our staff provides care for elderly adults, adults with special needs and adults with Alzheimer's. Our participants enjoy a fun, engaging and safe setting as we help them maintain their current skill levels, empowering them to stay in their familiar home environment.

## Day Habilitation Program

Our Day Habilitation Program offers a fun, engaging environment to work on developing and/or maintaining life skills and achieving community integration. We offer various recreational activities and volunteer opportunities throughout the week, along with a varied social calendar to help our participants make friends and develop new skills to help them live independent, integrated and fulfilling lives.
